The Jews take advantage of every opportunity to grow rich; first by excluding the Arabs from economic life, and also by acting as intermediaries for the victors of the moment.

The reception that the Jews gave to the Allies was considerable; too considerable to have any happy repercussion on the country. Infact, all the Jews from the populous neighborhoods sathered together in front of the Residency and in the Avenue de Paris, thus swamping by their number the worthwhile French who were for us. They at once acted as if it were their own exclusive victory. Then from the order hey rushed down to the American Consulate and offered their services as interpreters, besieved all Anglo-American administrations e.g. town-order, requisitin-service, ravitaillement, Maafi, etc., in order to take the onsolves indispensable and earn money. earn money.

Meanwhile, the intellectual Jews overwhelm the English with invitations to dinner and drines, to get acquainted, Gaston-Levy besieges the economic services of Civil Affairs, obtains a post for his son-in-law Felix de Couet in the service of American requisition of Labour, Jewish influence can be felt everywhere; this is new honsieur belix de Couet uses the German method (but in a contrary sense), against the Arabs, by arresting in a street 'rafle' all the natives, and taking them away by force to the yards where they are paid 25 firs a day.

All information services are helped by the Jews, who denounce only their pet-aversions, the Arabs. H. Lucien & adj. and his brother H. Menri Smadja with their aversion for the Arabs, while arrests with no discernment

(It is insisted that General Giraud is going to mobilize all young Mussulmans without distinction, from which fact great emotion exists in Tunisian families who know that wherever they do, with the French, with De Gaulle or Giraud; they will be badly treated in their armies.)

All the aditation and vengeance created by the Jews has made a deplorable propaganda for the Allies, as it conforms the assertions of the Germans

FRENCH REACTION AND THE MUSSELMAN SITUATION

Taking advantage of the absence of General Mast, of the disorganization of the Folice services, the Security Militaire reigns terror. Arrests on denunciations, abusive requisitions, vexations. The war seems ended, accounts are settled with the Arabs, their flocks confiscated for the benefit of French farmers (Djebel Layoun).

What does the Arab say? He is terrified, and buries himself in his house. Those more courageous ones move around and try to see the American Consuls and ask them to save them. On the whole, he detests the French and also hates the English me says that all the English are under the control of the Jews, that the English seek to play the game of the French. It is obvious they all look to the Americans; they have heard of their distribution of cotton goods and supplies. They say that Tunisia interests the Americans that they will not leave, on the contrary the law of 'Lease-lend' will permit America to say in Tunisia for 99 years.

Also, the incident of 26th May has done much for American propaganda. Some Jews accompanied by English soldiers who request the Sidi Merdoum quarters went into the Arab neighbourhood and wanted to force their way into beir houses. The Arabs defended themselves, helped by several Americans who were passing through. Several Jews were injured.

Another day, the French police raided the streets to pick up Arab orkmen; an American commandant nearby took the part of the Arabs for he was horrified at the treatment of thse poor fellows. All the Arabs cried out /ive America, Vice the Americans. Not a word for the French. These will take their revenge later.

Churchill said, speaking of Hitler, "The world is not ruled by tanks." The Arabs say about the French in Tunisia, "One cannot be governed by gendarmes."

The Arabs in Tunisia are expecting a declaration from America on thier behalf. Soon they will make a move if they are waiting in vain. In any case a hatred is becoming stronger between the Arabs on one side and the French and the Jews on the other.

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
