Algiera, jist January, 1943.

Sir,

We have the honour to send you herewith:

- 1- A memorandwa summarising the principal conclusions of the Report which the ALGERIAN JEWISH COMMITTEE OF SOCIAL STUDIES has addressed to the principal personalities of the Jewish world and to the allied authorities. We take the liberty in this connection to insist on the decisive aid which could be rendered by the arrival here of a friendly personality and particularly a Zionist.
- 2- Copy of a note which we have to-day addressed to the Director of the "PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE DIVISION" at Algiers.

We are aware that questions of this kind are at present occupying the attention of the Interallied Committee at Washington and we think you will not be unaware of the interest of the solution which we propose.

From the Zionist point of view, it is clear that such a solution accords with the widest Zionist doctrine and could not but be favourable to us.

We hope therefore that you will support it with the competent authorities of your country.

The Jews of Algeria, by the very situation in which they find themselves to-day, should be in a position to make an essential contribution to the solution of a millenary problem which inevitably will be presented to the Peace Conference.

With these ideas in mind, we request your advice and your assistance.

We beg you to be kind enough to cable us the safe receipt of this letter and ask you to accept the expression of our devoted sentiments.
