SUBJECT: REPORT ON THE ANTI-SEMITIC LEGISLATION STILL  
ACTIVELY IN FORCE IN ALGERIA.

A number of documents drawn up by leading Members of the Jewish community in Algiers, setting forth in some detail the racial laws which have been in force since the French Armistice of 1940. These reports are intended both as a summary of the present situation and as an appeal to the Allied powers for reparation of past injustices and for the complete restoration of citizen rights.

Note. The packet was brought to this country by hand and was handed over for Censorship examination. It was transferred to this Department by the Air Section.

The second cover contains only a personal hand-written note from B. HELER, Engineer, 19 Boulevard Carnot, Algiers, which is of no interest, except in so far as it may provide a reason for the choice of route of the present correspondence.

Translation Extract:

I have tried vainly up to now to get into contact with you. I do not know what has happened to my letters, probably in some pigeon-hole. Perhaps by this route, I shall get into touch with you. If so, you would much oblige me by sending me a cable acquainting me with the safe receipt of this letter and further indicating what possibility there is for me and the friends to communicate directly with you..... All goes well here and we hope better since our friends have landed. We expect, however, a more decisive betterment, our patience is being put to a heavy test.... Happy men who breathes the air of liberty in a free country!
