Gisela Schwaetzer: to collect 200 Esc. for this month. Inquired on use of \$120 deposited here. Originally, we understood to her account, free money, to be used as she needed it, paid out 400\$ month on basis of loan. In mid-January, she declared money as a loan to her for specific purpose of evacuating son from Eng. to Lisbon. Refuses to have it for anything else. Regretted could not give package service to borthers for another month...n.b. advise Kraak.. Discussed with PAC who feels we should cut her from the releif roll or clarify the situation sufficiently in order to stop using more general funds for her. Checked payments, clarified point where loans became relief.

Lunch, then to Bernstein's, \$alked with Spiegel on case of Herman Gruenbaum passage, asking them to cable NY Hias that folks here would pay difference between \$250 now on deposit and amount required, as visa apparently unobtainable without this assurance from here. He agreed, but Bernstein later vetoed, had Spiegl call requesting info on donor, looks like stall.
