## Aug 6

Grammar lesson this morning, after visit to Argentine consulate to inquire about a needy case Phil is working on, and about sending cable for Wavreck, not worth while, too little chance at present time. Yet his passport becomes invalid in November. Long talkwith Mrs. Wohlwill re Ruth Oettinger, worried about deportations from "Free" France, cabled Richie on her whereabouts.

After lunch consulted Lachaud to assure him permit had been extended for food already shipped out, and to tell him to wait on further purchases. Arranged for showing of film in France we are sending through, talked with Geesteranus on Phil's needy case, seeking new visa, arranged to deliver letter to him on te subject.
