Dear Josephine:

Thank you very much for the list from Mr. Blank of November 14th and the clipping from the Aufbau which you sent on. The factual information is (in addition to the rather fragmentary reports that we have already received from Leslie Heath, who, as you know, is the Service Committee representative in Casablanca. Leslie had only been able to visit one of the refugee camps before the American occupation began but after a long silence since that event we have heard from him today thru Lisbon, indicating that he sees a practical program aiding in Camp problems and civilian needs. How far it will be possible to go with this program and whether other workers can be used in that area cannot properly be determined for some time. You may be sure, however, that North Africa is an immediate focus of Service Committee interest.
