Dear Kendall,

Margaret Frawley has asked for my comments on the Algiers financial report which has been forwarded via Paul Gordon. I am also asked to comment on the budget which was received several weeks ago. I am working on Washington to get the \$20,000 (one million francs) restored for use in North Africa, and I expect to be down in Washington again on Friday on that and several other affairs, and will write further very shortly.

I am concerned at the moment that the contribution from the Anti-Fascist Committee of New York is such an appreciable proportion of the total expenditures in North Africa at the present time because I know that they have need of their funds in many places, and I will feel a little easier in my own conscience if the money originally given by us for use in North Africa is so expended.

I think there will be no serious difficulty in getting these arrangements worked out as soon as the people all return from the Atlantic City UNRRA Conference and have a day or two in Washington in which to recover from it.
