It is possible that J.A.F.R.O. funds budgeted in your memo of Dec. 7, 1943, will not be large enough to include both the necessary relief and the salaries (francs 3,400.00) of the secretary and of another badly needed assistant (francs 3,000. 0).

There is a strong feeling in the Amicale membership that administrative costs be kept down to allow more relief. This results in the secretary's being badly overworked.

Unless you see some objection I propose to keep the secretary on the CFRRO payroll where he now is, and Mr. Johnson proposes to pay the new assistant from AFSC funds until such time as the J.A.F.R.O. fund situation clarifies as to arrivals and our budgetary needs are better known here.
