These men are working under very severe conditions in the camp of Berguent, and would, I am sure, welcome the opportunity to work for the Americans.

I will, very shortly, be able to turn over to you a similar list for the camp of Im-Fout.

I also attach copy of a separate letter received from Mr. Oettinger of the HICEM Organization, giving the particulars of three other men from Bou-Arfa and Sidi El Ayachi, who might be particularly useful to you in the construction of barracks.
